### **Babysitter Safety Course**

Safe Sitter is a medically accurate program that teaches young adolescents how to handle emergencies when caring for children. This class teaches safe and nurturing childcare techniques, behavior management skills and appropriate responses to medical emergencies. This class is designed for young adults 11-13 years old.

### **BLS For Healthcare Provider**

The BLS for Healthcare Provider course is designed to teach skills of CPR for victims of all ages. This course includes the use of ventilation with a barrier device, a bag-mask device, use of an AED and relief of foreign-body airway obstruction. It is intended for participants who provide healthcare to patients in a wide variety of healthcare settings, including but not limited to physicians, nurses, paramedics and emergency medical technicians. Upon the successful completion of this course the participant will receive a course completion card.

### **C.P.R. for Family and Friends**

The C.P.R. for Family and Friends course targets all lay rescuers who want to learn rescue skills for loved ones. This course is designed to teach skills of CPR and relief of foreign-body airway obstruction to all lay rescuers. No course completion card is issued.

### **Family & Friends 1st Aid & CPR for Children**

The Family & Friends 1st Aid and CPR course targets those caring for infants and children, like parents, grandparents or babysitters. This program teaches what to do in the first few minutes until help arrives. This course covers CPR as well as preventing injuries, recognizing and treating basic first aid emergencies. No course completion card is issued.

### **Heartsaver AED**

The Heartsaver AED course is designed to teach the skills of CPR for victims of all ages. This course includes the use of ventilation with a barrier device, use of an AED and relief of foreign-body airway obstruction. It is intended for participants who need a course completion card, other than healthcare workers.

### **Heartsaver 1st Aid With C.P.R.**

The Heartsaver 1st Aid with C.P.R. course is designed to teach skills of General Principles, Medical Emergencies, Injury Emergencies and Environmental Injuries to all lay rescuers. This course also teaches the skills of CPR and the use of an AED. It is intended for participants who are expected to be first responders to a medical emergency. Upon the successful completion of this course the participant will receive a course completion card.
