## Approve Full Time Testing Process with IO Solutions

He would like to keep the process similar to last time and is hoping to get a good turnout. IO Solutions will need to be contacted to lock in available upcoming dates.

## Changes to Preference Points

The Commissioner's reserve the right to issue up to 5 preference points of their choosing. Attorney Motylinski was contacted via telephone to provide guidance. The option of adding points for the trades has been previously discussed. It was determined trades is a broad term and Commis Herrick thought this needed to be narrowed down.
The Commissioners also discussed possibly adding 2.5 points for membership in a Mabas 19 water rescue, tech rescue or hazmat team. This is something to still consider.

MOTION by Herrick, seconded by Swyndro to add 2.5 preference points for completion of an apprenticeship program in the trades and 2.5 points for Division 19 special teams. Motion Carries.
