Takeaways to Review with your Crews

- Backing Incident
 - Review Backing SOP with crews (Find it on the Manhattan Website)
 - Drivers should be aware they are responsible for looking in the mirror to ensure the door is up before entering the bay
 - Drivers need to look up before pulling out to ensure the door is up, along with the officer.
 - Before the apparatus starts backing, the **spotters** need to look back to ensure the door is all the way up
 - Drivers are going faster than the spotter while backing. Stress to your drivers that they should slow down and take their time.
- Hand Injury
 - During rig checks, everyone assigned to that rig should be making sure all compartments and equipment are organized, and all equipment can be easily removed from the compartment.
- Lifting and Moving
 - Review all lifting and moving devices with your crews. Make sure all members are aware of the devices we keep on our apparatus. I.E. Binder Lift
 - \circ Tell your members if they need help to safely move a patient, CALL FOR HELP.
